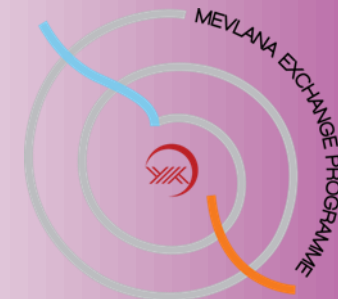
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OBJECTIVES OF MEVLANA EXCHANGE PROGRAM

MEVLANA EXCHANGE PROGRAM

WHAT IS IT?

Mevlana Exchange Programme is a programme which aims the exchange of students and academic staff between the Turkish higher education institutions and higher education institutions of other countries.

WHO CAN BENEFIT ?

Students registered in formal education programmes in Associate Degree, BA, MA, and PhD level at higher education institutions in Turkey and international partner universities can benefit from this program.

All academic staff who work in a Turkish or foreign higher education institute after signing the Mevlana Protocol may participate to the exchange program.

HOW LONG IS THE EXCHANGE?

Students can apply for one or two semesters while this duration is between 1 week and 3 months for academic staff.



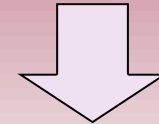
WHICH COUNTRIES CAN I GO?

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?



- 1-Grade point average (GPA) of associate degree and undergraduate students must be at least 2.5 on a four point scale; and 3.0 for graduate students (MA, PhD),
- 2-Students must take a language exam that could be organised by Atatürk University.

- 1-Students are paid scholarships which differ according to the host country,
- 2-Students continue to take their other scholarships and grants in their home countries.
- 3-Students do not pay any tuition fees to the host institution during the program.
